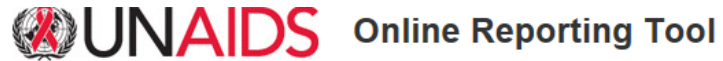

The Global AIDS Monitoring indicator data should be submitted through this reporting website to enhance the completeness and quality of the data and to facilitate processing and analysis at the country, regional and global levels.

The deadline for submission using the reporting website is **31 March 2017**.

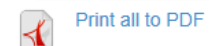

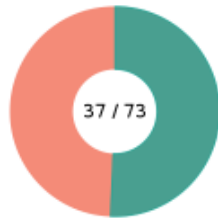

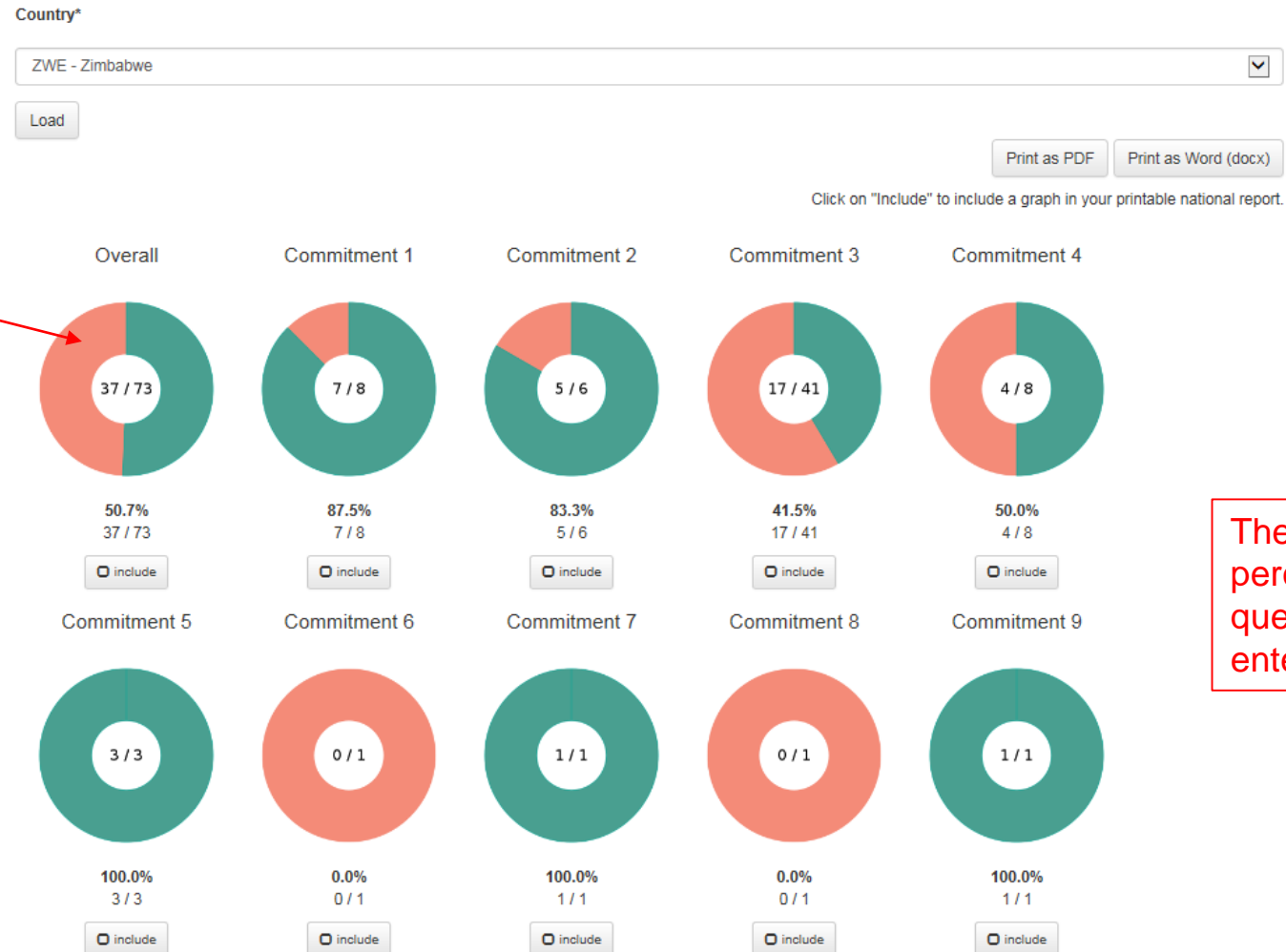

The doughnut graphs display the percentage of indicators (+ policy questions) for which data were entered.

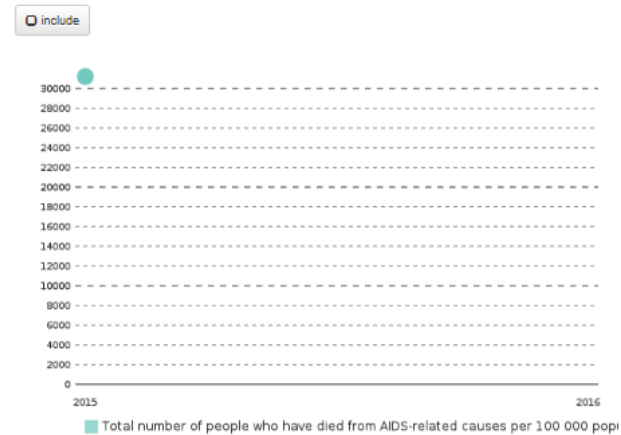

Summary

 1. Log in the online reporting tool www.aidsreportingtool.unaids.org with your credentials
 2. Select a country under the “Dashboard” tab
 3. Select the figures you wish to include, write a progress summary for each commitment and save it to the narrative report
 4. Print the report as pdf or Word.
- You may use the narrative report for national consultations and to share with your partners.
- You may edit and reproduce the narrative report through the online tool based on your national consultations.
- Narrative reports will be shared on the UNAIDS website.
